We've celebrated Easter just about as early as it comes but then, every Sunday is an Easter celebration. We celebrate Jesus' Resurrection on the 3rd day and that is Sunday. It seems to me that as we enter April we use this time to not only renew our faith in Christ, but that we make a point of sharing our faith with others. Did not Jesus command his disciples to "go into all the world, making disciples, and baptizing them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit?" Of course.

Now, lots of decisions are before us. After lots of prayer and discussion the Session on Sunday, March 16th, has voted **not** to continue merger conversations with our brothers and sisters in the Cathedral City Community Presbyterian Church. Why? Because to lose our identity as the Palm Springs Presbyterian Church would be to lose that which attracts many to our church—even as hidden as we are in SDA church facilities.

Ahead of us lies, **first**, the search for our own facility—possibly the old Palm Springs Community Church on the corner of Baristo and Cahuilla...or some other location. But, that could be expensive and lots of work. Also ahead of us lies, **second**, the active searches for a called, permanent, pastor which is vital to our growth even as much as I love being your interim pastor and growing in faith with you. A **third** challenge for us is growing: not only spiritually, but also numerically and financially. We have to do all three! And it will take commitments from those of us who are full-time residents and from you, our winter residents.

Are we up to this? I believe so. Why do I say this? Because of you and because I trust our God to guide and enable us.

So, as Joyce and I prepare to fly to Israel, Egypt, and Jordan from the middle of April to the middle of May, you will be in our prayers. While we are gone, you have two excellent people filling our pulpit: **the Rev. Dr. Ken McCullen and the Rev. Dr. Art Ihnen**. They are a blessing and you will be blessed. But, please, keep Joyce and me in your prayers as we fly thousands of miles and see wonderful, biblical and historic places. When we return, on Sunday May 11th we will give you a DVD hint of our adventure during worship.

Thank you all and God bless you and your loved ones in 2008.

Minutes of prior Session and Congregation meetings were read and approved with minor corrections. Pastor Bill requested of Session that the Rev. Dr. Ken McCullen be invited to be our Parish Associate and that we request the Presbytery of Riverside to concur.

The Session adjourned and the Corporation convened to elect corporate officers: President, Bob Wulf; Vice President, Jim De Hart; Secretary, Jackie Morgan; Treasurer, Harvey Stephens. Session then reconvened to hear reports from committees.

An Ice Cream Social has been scheduled for April 13, 2008 immediately following worship to help raise money for Women's Ministry. It was reported that we raised \$1,225.00 for the One Great Hour of Sharing! Congratulations for this extra mile giving to share as God has blessed us.

A special Session meeting has been called for Wednesday, April 2nd to discuss the pros and cons of the old Palm Springs Community Church. The regular Session meeting, scheduled for April 9th has been postponed and will only meet if so called. PRAYER COMMITMENT

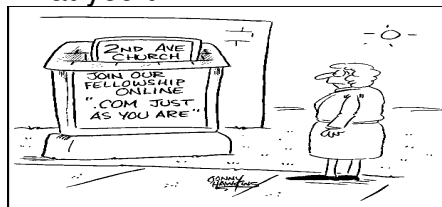

Thank You

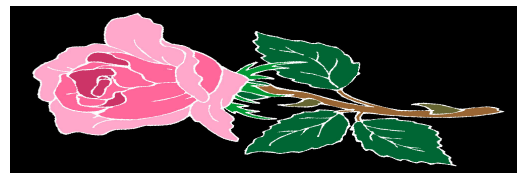

DEACON'S CORNER

From Hope Curtiss' Kitchen

BARBECUE SANDWICHES

- 1 boneless beef chuck roast (1 1/2 #)
- 1 boneless pork loin rib end roast (1 1/2#)
- 1 cup chopped onion
- 1 cup chopped green pepper
- 1/2 cup brown sugar packed down
- 1/4 cup cider vinegar
- 1 tbl chili powder
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 tsp ground mustard
- 2 tsp Worcestershire Sauce
- 1 6 oz can tomato paste
- 15 sandwich buns, split

Spray a 4-5 quart slow cooker with Pam.

Trim fat from meat. Cut meat in 3 inch pieces and place in cooker with remaining ingredients except tomato paste.

Cover and cook on low for 8-10 hours. Remove meat with slotted spoon. Shred meat with two forks; strain liquid in cooker. Reserve liquid. Return vegetables and meat to cooker and stir in tomato paste. Stir in reserved liquid (1-2 cups) for desired moistness. Cover and cook on high 10-15 min. until hot. Spoon the meat mixture onto the buns.
